WHY PRIORITIZE ISTANBUL?

Potential spread is the main reason to choose Istanbul. Istanbul is the cultural, economic, and historical center of Turkey. If the gospel transformed this city, the ripple effects would quickly reach every province of the country and the Balkans. Istanbul is THE domino that makes all the others fall.

Istanbul is home to 3 million Kurdish residents, making it the largest Kurdish population globally. With more and more access to Turkish Kurdistan being denied to workers and local Christians, Istanbul provides unique access to the largest concentration of these predominantly inaccessible and unengaged people. The same is true for Syrian refugees.

Because of urbanization in Turkey, Istanbul now provides an opportunity to engage with people from the more rural provinces that are difficult/impossible to gain long—term residence. For example, there are more residents from the provinces of Sivas, Tunceli, Erzincan, Kastamonu, Sinop, Giresun, and Bayburt in Istanbul than there are in those provinces. To reach the East, we can start in the West.

Unfortunately, most workers in Istanbul stay in the same areas of town and cluster together instead of spreading out into the poorer, more devout, and more opportunity-rich neighborhoods.

OPPORTUNITIES

- We have people working in the arts and photography reaching out to all sectors of society through this sector.
- People are working at multiple levels in the education sector: high school and university teachers, students in Master's and Ph.D. programs, and independent coaches for educators and other professionals.
- Anything an innovative, creative, and apostolic mind can think of is
