Moroccan Arabs are one of the 30 largest unreached PGs in the world. Casablanca is the largest city in Morocco, easily tripling the population of its 2nd largest. 1/5 of Morocco's population lives within an hour's drive, yet most have no idea who Jesus is or what he has done for them.

Under the shadow of the world's tallest minaret, the city teems with densely packed neighborhoods of urban poor and working class people from the outlying commuter towns. They come from nearly every village in Morocco and maintain close connections with their kin, returning to their mountain villages for weddings, funerals and holidays. Amazigh (Berber) Sousse <Soo see> speakers from the south dominate the small-stores and taxi industries. Although they have their own distinct language and culture, these indigenous North Africans speak Arabic.

The western edge of this modern metropolis overlooks the Atlantic Ocean, where tourists and locals alike enjoy all kinds of water sports and salt air. To the east are fertile lands and mountains. Despite thriving as the economic and industrial center, Casa still maintains a quintessential North African ease. Millenia of Middle Eastern and European rule has resulted in a cosmopolitan, world class city that gets along well with foreigners. With 1 worker for every 86,000 people, there is much to be done! **Will you consider coming?**
