There are large populations of Syrian Refugees in Turkey that are completely unengaged. Only Istanbul, Ankara and Izmir would be considered engaged. (And still, there are large populations of Syrians in some neighborhoods in Istanbul that are totally unengaged.). Most other provinces have Syrian Refugee populations with no witness.

The overwhelming majority of workers among Syrian refugees are focused on relief work and some development, which are huge needs among the refugee population. However, for the most part, neither church planting nor DMM is not happening among Syrian Refugees in Turkey.



Opportunities to Engage

Many Syrians want to make a new life in Turkey; they are not planning to go back to Syria. Doors to the west are closing for refugees. Subsequently, the less transient the Syrian refugee population, the better the conditions are for church planting. Undoubtedly Syrian refugees suffer from trauma, but five years from now, they will be in a different place, practically and psychologically speaking. Many will have integrated into Turkish society. They will have created more stability in their lives. We need workers now.

There are 4-6 teams currently serving the refugee population in Turkey which opportunities for: Arabic speakers from the Arab world willing to relocate to Turkey and work among Syrians. First-time field workers who already know Arabic. Teachers who can do After-School tutoring in a variety of subjects. Those with knowledge or experience in developing "After School Programs." Entrepreneurs who can start businesses that cater to Syrians or can provide jobs for Syrians.
