





## **Quick Facts**

Population: Approximately 3.2 million

Languages: Urdu, Punjabi

<u>Gospel resources</u>: Bible and other Christian literature in Urdu, Jesus Film, satellite TV programs, Internet, mobile media with Bible stories and studies. Faisalabad is Pakistan's third largest city, located in the country's most populous province, Punjab. A sprawling city, Faisalabad's urban area covers 1,300 square kilometers (500 square miles) and is in the agricultural and industrial heartland of Pakistan, which is well known for its textile industry. Cotton grown across the province is processed into fabric in the city's many textile mills and sewn into clothing in garment factories. The city is also home to several universities, medical colleges, and a large technical college.

Faisalabad's Muslim majority makes up 97% of the city; Sunnis predominate though Shias and still smaller numbers of Ismailis are also present in the city. There is a small Christian minority (~ 2%), including some involved in outreach to their neighbors.

## **Opportunities to Engage**

Faisalabad's vibrant business environment could accommodate foreign workers starting or joining a local enterprise. For those wishing to establish a business, it might be advisable to first spend some time living in a nearby city, such as Lahore, where foreign businesspeople have long been accepted. After a period, moving or expanding to Faisalabad might then be better received. Business contacts could offer opportunities for making acquaintances and friends, and with them opportunities for sharing the gospel.

With several colleges and universities in Faisalabad, including medical colleges, and engineering and trade schools, the possibility of faculty positions for foreign workers may be explored. Expatriates have taught at in universities in Pakistan and having well-qualified foreign instructors can boost a university's prestige. A faculty position would naturally provide personal contacts among local people.

There are a few dozen churches and church-based ministries in Faisalabad, varying in background, size, and capacity.

## **Prayer Points**

- Pray for local believers as they live among their Muslim neighbors. Ask God to give them courage to share the gospel in appropriate ways.

- More recordings of the Bible in the local Punjabi dialect are needed.
